

H.H.H. RANCH CO. HUNT AGREEMENT

To fully enjoy your hunt, we ask your cooperation in following these safety rules:

1. Hunting will be done either while walking with a guide or from the hunting blinds. There will be no shooting from a vehicle en route to, or back from the blinds.
2. Hunters should not leave their respective blinds to hunt on foot. In the event that a game animal is wounded but not killed, the hunter is to stay at or near the blind until the guide comes to help trail the animal. Hunters may not return to the lodge on foot except by special permission from the guide.
3. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed while hunting. Period.
4. While being transported in the guide's vehicle, all guns must be unloaded. The firearm chambers must be open with gun barrels pointed toward the floor of the vehicle. Firearms must remain outside the hunting lodge.
5. Vehicles belonging to hunters are not allowed away from the lodge. Each guest is responsible for his/her gear.
6. The hunt for a buck or doe ends when (a) the hunter kills the animal or (b) blood is drawn from the animal.
7. No shots are to be fired at an animal found across a ranch perimeter fence or boundary.
8. Hunters are forbidden to shoot at any species of animal or bird other than what is specified in the Booking Agreement, unless they have special permission from the guide.
9. In the event that a hunter kills game in excess of his/her limit as specified by the H.H.H. Ranch Co. Hunting Camp, the hunter will forfeit to the H.H.H. Ranch Co. the excess game together with all other game already taken.
10. Each hunter must have a valid Texas hunting license, and each hunter agrees to abide by the rules and the spirit of the game regulations of the State of Texas and the H.H.H. Ranch Co. Hunting Camp. Failure to abide by the above rules will cancel the balance of the hunt.

WAIVER OF CLAIMS/INDEMNITY

Hunter acknowledges that Hunting entails known and unanticipated risks, which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to himself, to property, or to third parties. Hunter understands that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. Hunter expressly agrees and promises to accept and assume all of the risks existing in this activity. Hunter participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and he/she elects to participate in spite of the risks. Hunter hereby voluntarily releases, forever discharges, and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless H.H.H. Ranch Co. from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, which are in any way connected with his/her participation in this activity or his/her use of H.H.H. Ranch's equipment or facilities, including and such Claims which allege negligent acts or omissions of hunter. Should H.H.H. Ranch Co. or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, hunter agrees to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.

Hunter certifies that he/she has adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage he/she may cause or suffer while participating, or else hunter agrees to bear the costs of such injury or damage himself or herself. Hunter further certifies that he/she has no medical or physical conditions, which could interfere with his/her safety in this activity, or else hunter is willing to assume – and bear the costs of – all risks that may be created, directly, by any such condition.

By signing this document, hunter acknowledges that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during his/her participation in this activity, he/she may be found by a court of law to waive his/her right to maintain a lawsuit against H.H.H. Ranch Co. on the basis of any claim from which hunter has released them here in.
